Speakers

Dr. Ed Tronik (Developmental and clinical psychologist) - USA



Distinguished Professor of Psychology at the University of Massachusetts Boston, director of the Child Development Unit, a research associate in Newborn Medicine, lecturer at Harvard Medical School, associate professor at both the Graduate School of Education and the School of Public Health at Harvard.

He's a member of the Boston Psychoanalytic Society and Institute and founder and faculty member of the Touchpoints program. Along with other researcher associates, he created the Infant-Parent Mental Health Post Graduate Certificate Program at the University of Massachusetts Boston.

His work has been focused on developing scales for behavioral and neurobehavioral assessments in newborns; as well as caretaking, maternal depression effects and other affective disorders during the early childhood.

Dr. Tronik developed the Still face paradigm and he continues to do research on epigenetic processes affecting behavior.

He published more than 200 scientific articles and 4 books.

His research is funded by NICHD and NSF.

Dr. Mariano Rosabal (Psychologist, 1963) - Costa Rica

Degree in Psychology from the Universidad de Costa Rica and Doctorate in Development Psychology and Culture from the University of Osnabrück, Germany. He's a research associate at the Psychological Research Institute and Professor for the Psychology School at the Universidad de Costa Rica.

He's been working as psychoterapist for children, teenagers and adults for over 25 years and as an occasional consultant in first infant matters for UNICEF/Costa Rica.

Dr. Rosabal areas of interest are intercultural psychology, parenting and culture, human development and social changes, as well as socialization in adverse contexts (divorce, neglect).

He works with parent-child psychoterapy models and he had developed initiatives for the social action college frame, specifically through the "School for parents/UCR" program.
